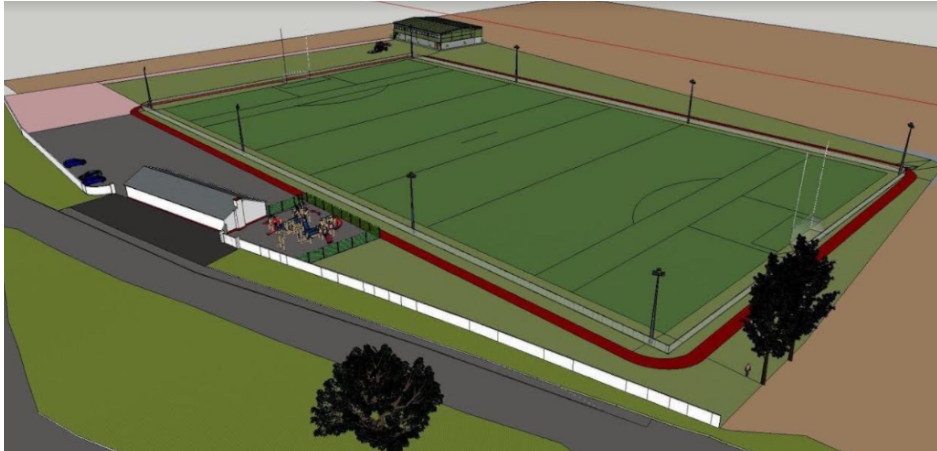
Phase 1 - Completed 2019 - 2021

- Construction of a Indoor Hurling Arena with state of the art all-weather pitch.



Phase 2 - Target Development - 2022

- Fencing and main pitch railing
- Redevelopment of our walking track



Phased 3

- Development of a state of the art gym, meeting rooms, showers and toilets adjacent to the Indoor Hurling Arena.



Why do we need to undertake this development?

Our playing facilities are now at capacity and are also outdated. Throughout the year we provide Gaelic Games to over 120 children and 45 adults in our club. It is hoped that the construction of these facilities will serve to keep our club to the forefront of Laois G.A.A and enhance the lives of our members and our community. This development will significantly enhance the infrastructure and environment to encourage participation in our games - but it can only be done with our collective support.
